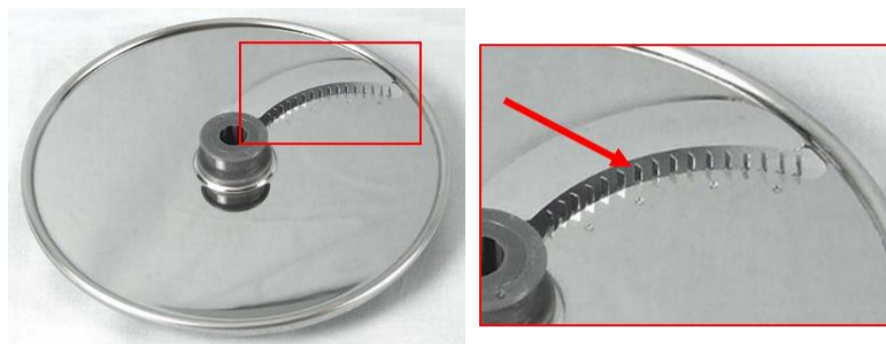


# Product Safety Recall



The rating label underside the main unit indicates the type FPM800 or FPM810 and the date code (only 19xxx, 20xxx and 21xxx are involved).

**Julienne disc for Kenwood food processor models FPM810 and FPM800 manufactured between 1 January 2019 and 31 December 2021 and sold by kitchenware and electronics stores**

**Identification:** The Julienne disc is included as an accessory with food processor models FPM810 and FPM800 and can easily be identified by looking at the date code on the packaging or rating information label.

Only date codes 19xxx, 20xxx and 21xxx are affected.

The food processors themselves and other discs and accessories are not affected.

**Defect:** Parts of the Julienne disc may break off during use.

**Hazard:** Users may ingest metal pieces, which may cause injury.

**What to do:** Consumers should stop using the Julienne disc and visit <http://juliennedisc.kenwoodworld.com> to register to receive a free replacement disc. Consumers will be asked to dispose of the affected disc.
