

Product safety recall

KitchenAid digital pen/quick response thermometer

LIFETIME BRANDS AUSTRALIA PTY LIMITED

KitchenAid digital thermometer used for measuring cooking temperatures.



Reason the product is recalled

The product doesn't comply with the [mandatory information standard for products containing button/coin batteries](#).

The packaging is missing warning information about:

- the dangers of button/coin batteries to children
- what to do when a person suspects someone has swallowed or placed a button/coin battery inside any part of their body.

The hazards to consumers

Children are at risk of choking, severe internal burn injuries or death if they swallow or place button or coin batteries inside their bodies.

Serious injury can occur in as little as 2 hours and the results can be fatal. In Australia, children have suffered serious injuries or died from swallowing button/coin batteries.

If you suspect a child has swallowed or inserted a button/coin battery:

- **Call Triple Zero (000)** if your child is bleeding or having any difficulty breathing.
- Call the Poisons Information Centre immediately on 13 11 26, available 24 hours a day. They can direct you to an appropriate medical facility.

Early action can save lives. Do not wait for symptoms to develop.

What consumers should do

1. Stop using the product immediately and keep it out of reach of children.
2. Return the thermometer to the place of purchase or Lifetime Brands Australia for a full refund.
