Blendjet 2 Portable Blenders, all models, with serial numbers 5201000000 to 5542999999

Identification: A portable blender with a compact battery is sold in a variety of colours. The lithium-ion battery is rechargeable with a USB cable.

The affected Units are among the following serial numbers: 5201000000 and 5542999999 Consumers should enter their full serial number into the specific landing page to confirm that their portable blender is included in the recall:

The BlendJet 2 Portable Blender has been sold online and in Retailers across Australia, including JB Hi-Fi, Myer, The Good Guys, Harvey Norman and Kitchen Warehouse.

Hazard: BlendJet Ltd. has detected two manufacturing defects in affected units. In certain circumstances of intensive use, a blender blade may break off, releasing a fragment, with the consequent risk of laceration of an internal digestive organ if it is swallowed. Additionally, in certain circumstances or while charging, the Printed Circuit Board (PCB) may go overhead, causing a short circuit, with the consequent risk of fire.

Action required: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled blenders and contact BlendJet for a free BlendJet 2 base unit replacement. Contact BlendJet Inc.:
